

# Singular Possessive Nouns

To show that one person, animal, or thing owns something, use a **singular possessive noun**. Add an apostrophe (') and the letter s to a singular noun to make it possessive.

**Singular Noun**

The bear slept all day.

**Singular Possessive Noun**

The hare did not like the bear's laziness.
