Draw Conclusions

- When you **draw a conclusion**, you figure out something by using clues and what you know.
- Remember that drawing conclusions means thinking about facts and details and then making a decision that makes sense.

1. A crow track has three marks, while a snake track looks like a long winding line.
 Tracks make patterns.
 Snake tracks are bigger than crow tracks.

 Many animal tracks show four toes.
3. Fireflies flutter and bees fly. Neither fireflies nor bees walk much on the ground.
 Fireflies and bees don't leave tracks.
