1. This Selection Snapshot has many details, such as the number of steps to the statue’s top. Find other details. How do details help you know the Statue of Liberty?

Responses will vary; details help the reader visualize the size and meaning of the Statue of Liberty.

2. This Snapshot was written in the order in which events happened. What clue words did you notice that helped you recognize the sequential text structure?

Possible responses: Dates begin in 1871 and move through 1886; clue words include *later* and *then*.

3. Imagine that you have a pen pal who has never seen the Statue of Liberty, even in a picture. Write a description for your pen pal. Be sure to use boldface words from the Snapshot.

Responses will vary but should include an understanding of the boldface words and of the Snapshot.
